The Foreign Credential Recognition (FCR) loans program is funded in part by the Federal Government of Canada to help **skilled newcomers** get back into their professional field or an alternative related career field. FCR is a process to verify that your education and work experience, obtained in another country, is equivalent to the standards established by the Canadian workforce.

- Receive multiple loans up to \$30,000 at lower interest rates (prime + 0%).
- The FCR loans can be used for;
 - Credential Evaluation
 - Association & Exam fees
 - Books & Course Materials
 - Short - Term Bridge Training
 - Travel Expenses/Living Allowance
